Valentina Colcelli (PhD) is a Senior Researcher at Italian National Research Council (CNR). Her main research interests focus on the interaction of domestic and European law in shaping rights and interests and market regulation. She also has a research interest in a general reflection on personal and non-personal data beyond the EU legal system, internal market regulation, Technology Transfer, legal and ethical issues in research and innovation activities, and adequate judicial protection of biodiversity in light of fundamental rights. She published books concerning EU integration and more than 80 papers. She is a member of several projects funded by the EU and long-lasting international research cooperation, like the H2020. Among them, in the project Pro-Cancer-1 (h2020) she studies legal and ethical aspects addressed on the image biobanks and the application of the system of AI to develop imaging biomarkers. In whole projects, she is involved in the WPS devoted to the definition of the privacy policy of the biobanks, prior consent information definition and drafting Material Transfer Agreement. She is co-chair of the Working Group "Regulatory, Ethics, and GDPR" for the Scientific Association "European, Middle East & African for Biopreservation and Biobanking" (ESBB) and a member of the ESBB Council. She is Visiting External examiner at the University of Malta and an external professor at the University of Perugia.
